The new 2023 Manual is available!!!

In case you haven't heard, the new Manual 2023 is now in force for the Church of the Nazarene. It is not in print yet, but pre-orders can be placed with The Foundry, our publishing house at www.resources.nazarene.org. The legislation of the 2023 Manual is in effect and supersedes all other versions of the Manual immediately. Without having you read the entire thing through, I thought it might be helpful if I provided a few highlights of important changes and where you might find them.

28-29.6 The Christian Life: This entire section has been rewritten to express our core commitment to holiness of heart and life in a way that projects that commitment into the complicated world in which we live. This section is an excellent piece out of which to disciple our people in terms of not only how we should choose to live but why those choices matter in terms of our own soul-care and the care of the world in which we have been placed.

- 114.3, 143 Changed the length of time to remove an "inactive" member from membership from two years to one.
- 115.2 Authorizes local churches to hold meetings and vote electronically.
- 115.7-115.8 Requires that public notice of annual and special meetings be conveyed to the church at least two weeks in advance.
- 119 Provides that pastoral appointments may be for one or two years.
- 137.3. 149. 154-55 Allows the church board to fill vacancies on the board.
- 139.10 Changes pastoral sabbaticals to every 5th year of consecutive service to a church and suggests they last a minimum of 4 weeks.
- 147 Lowers the number stewards on the board from three to two.
- 225.19 Removed the need for a District Assembly Finance Committee and assigns that duty to the District Advisory Board if the District prefers.
- **302** The General Assembly is no longer required to meet in the month of June.
- 919 A long paragraph was added to the appendix of the Manual regarding our stance on gender identity which supports the idea that gender is assigned by God at birth and is not to be considered a choice to be made by an individual.

These are just a sampling of some of the legislative changes made in the Manual by our gathered church. What is great to remember that our Manual is not a law-book passed down by a court of clergy on holy high horses, it is OUR considered opinion as a body of Christ—lay and clergy coming together to think through hard topics and decide together how will find the way forward. In this way the Church of the Nazarene is unique. The whole church may not always agree, but we find agreement and we choose to work together for the sake of the mission of "making Christ-like disciples in the nations."


