In this email, I will cover the basic information about NYC, the cost of NYC, the payment plan, T-shirt contest, and the travel schedule.

Basic Information:

What: Nazarene Youth Conference 2023 (4-day conference filled with worship, teaching, interactive experiences, concerts)

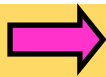

Greetings, NM District!

We are collecting names and pictures for the NMI Memorial Roll which we will share during the **NMI Convention**.

NOTE**** This is a different Memorial Roll than the District One played during District Assembly. Those are collected by someone else. This collection is for people who have been entered into the NMI Memorial Roll on the NMI Website. There is a \$75 fee which is used to support Nazarene missionaries.

From the NMI Website:

"The Memorial Roll, established in 1919, is a way to honor deceased friends and loved ones. A certificate is issued in the name of the person memorialized and is often presented to a family member or displayed in the church. Churches or individuals may place as many names on the Memorial Roll as they desire, and those memorialized need not be members of the church.

The cost of placing someone on the Memorial Roll is USD\$75. You will receive a certificate that fits into a standard 8"x10" frame. Duplicates of the certificate are \$25 each."

You can find all the information you need to enter someone on the NMI Memorial Roll at the NMI Website: nazarene.org/NMI under the tab labeled "Honors."

The Church of the Nazarene officially began work in Mexico in 1908. However, the roots of the work in Mexico can be traced all the way back to 1903 when members of the Texas Holiness Association moved to the south of Mexico, making Mexico one of the very first missions fields. The country borders the Caribbean Sea and the Gulf of Mexico, between Belize and the United States. It also borders the North Pacific Ocean, between Guatemala and the United States. The population is approximately 128.9 million. The official language is Spanish.

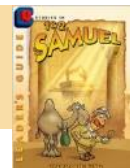
