#### The Power of Your Story

While at the funeral of Arnie Leidy a week ago, his son-in-law, Steve Sanchez reminded us all of the power that his testimony had when he shared it when he was preaching. Arnie's story was a real story of transformation. He had a true BC to AC story that revealed the power of Jesus to take a broken life and completely revolutionize it. When he told his story, it inspired hope and a desire for change in the life of the listener.

Pastor Steve reminded those that were gathered at Arnie's funeral that our story also has power. So does yours. Whether your story is a "rags to riches" conversion story or whether it is a "grace upon grace" story of having walked with Jesus all your life, your story of how Jesus has impacted your life is a story that has power.

When you tell your story, you give the Holy Spirit the opportunity to confirm its witness and its truth in the heart of the person who is hearing it. It is not up to you to convince people of the power of Christ through your story. In John 16:8, Jesus tells us that the Holy Spirit will convict the world regarding sin, righteousness, and judgement. Our job is just to tell our story so that the Holy Spirit has the opportunity to add the conformation to our witness.

I am reminded of the command that Jesus gave to the women who encountered Him at the empty tomb, "Do not be afraid, go and tell..." (Matt 28:10). This command, making women the first who were commissioned by Jesus to proclaim the good news, is the simple commission given to all of us in Matthew 28:19.

As witnesses to Jesus, our story has power to change lives. Whether that story is about how he saved us from our sinful rebellion or that story is about how he answered our prayer this week or spoke to us through Sunday's sermon or revealed something to us while we were reading scripture or helped us in a specific way this week. When you have an encounter with the resurrected Jesus, you have a commission to tell that story. When you do, the telling causes the faith of others to rise, and it cause unbelievers to come to trust in Jesus for their salvation.

So, tell your story and tell your stories. They have more power than you imagine.




Myanmar Earthquake Update – March 30, 2025


