Now GO!... but, Wait.

I suppose all of us are familiar with Jeremiah 29:11 and can probably quote it. In the NIV it reads, “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” It is a wonderful promise given by God through Jeremiah to the exiles in Babylon. For most of us, however, this promise has a resonance to it that makes it applicable to our lives as well. We know that “God loves us and has a wonderful plan for our lives” as well. Therefore, we have confidence that God’s plan is working its way out in our lives just as surely as it was working its way out in the lives of the exiled children of Judah.

Knowing this truth to be constant, we should attend to the instructions of verses 12-14a, “¹²Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. ¹³You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. ¹⁴I will be found by you,” declares the LORD.” Since God has a good plan for us, it only makes sense that we would want to spend time in prayer seeking to understand that plan, so that we can follow that plan, so that it can be accomplished in our lives. I think that the grave mistake we often make is that we stop at verse 11, knowing that God has a good plan, but we never see the plan realized because we do not take time to hear from God about the plan, so the plan is never executed in the way God intends.

This principle is what Jesus was expressing to his disciples when he gave them the Great Commission in Matthew 28:19, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel.” As Luke tells the account, he adds this instruction in 24:49, “but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.” In other words, Jesus told his disciples Go!..., but, wait.

They needed to wait until they were **Impowered** to accomplish the mission that Jesus was sending them on.

They needed to wait until they had **Invisioned** the specific vision that God had for them.


They needed to wait until they were **In Tune** with the purposes of God through the Holy Spirit.

What were they doing while they were waiting? They were praying. Prayer sourced their power, their vision, and their alignment with God.

In this season between Easter and Pentecost, we are, once again, being called to prayer as a USA/Canada region. The purpose of this season of prayer is to discover how God is calling our churches to Bless our Communities. We want to come into alignment with the heart of God so that we can know his vision for our church and become the place where his power becomes active in our midst. Prayer is the key that unlocks the plan.
